

Ordinance 22-216

**Grant Project Ordinance for the Town of Fairmont
Streamflow Rehabilitation Assistance Program, Contract #22-080-4033**

BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Fairmont, North Carolina that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1: This ordinance is to establish a budget for a project to be funded by the North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Soil & Water. The Town of Fairmont will receive \$250,000 from the Streamflow Rehabilitation Assistance Program (StRAP) appropriated by the North Carolina General Assembly. These funds will be used for to remove vegetative debris from the Old Field Swamp and Pittman Mill Branch.

Section 2: The following amounts are appropriated for the project and authorized for expenditure:

Old Field Swamp, 750 linear feet of debris removal	\$97,350
Pittman Mill Branch, 1350 linear feet of debris removal, beaver dam removal	<u>\$152,650</u>
TOTAL	\$250,000

Section 3: The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete the project:

North Carolina Streamflow Rehabilitation Assistance Program	\$250,000
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
Section 4: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agency and the grant agreements.


Section 5: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to report the financial status of the project to the governing board on a monthly basis.

Section 6: Copies of this grant project ordinance shall be furnished to the Budget Officer, the Finance Officer and to the Clerk to Town Council.

Section 7: This grant project ordinance expires on December 31, 2024, or when all the StRAP funds have been obligated and expended by the town, whichever occurs sooner.
